

NOTICE N-3

« Customs service tariff for international containerized goods»

Effective Date: January 1st, 2025

This Notice is issued pursuant to section 49 of Part I of the Canada Marine Act, Chapter 10, 46-47 Elizabeth II, 1997-98



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Canada

1. General

- 1. This Notice may be cited as the: **Customs service tariff for international containerized goods**
- 2. This Notice is subject to the definitions given under Section 2.

2. Definitions

In this Notice,

- 1. « Authority » means the Montreal Port Authority as defined under Sections 2 and 8 of Part I of the Canada Marine Act and by its letters patent issued on March 1st, 1999;
- 2. « Harbour » or « Port of Montreal » legal and physical designation of all real properties that the Montreal Port Authority manages, holds or occupies as set out in Appendix A entitled "Description of Navigable Waters" and Appendix B entitled "Description of Federal Real Property" of its Letters Patent issued on March 1st, 1999, as stipulated in the Canada Marine Act;
- 3. « International containerized goods » means any containerized goods that may be subject to inspection by the Canada Border Services Agency.
- 4. « Port territory » is all terminals located on the territory of the Montreal Port Authority, Montreal-East and Contrecoeur.

3. Fees

The handling fees for all tonnage of international containerized goods are presented in Schedule I.

4. Calculation of fees

- Import and export rates are \$0.04 for all tonnage of international containerized goods;
- Monthly billing will be applied to terminal operators based on the tonnage of international containerized cargo handled;



6. Accrual and Payment of Fees

- 1) The customs service fees for international containerized goods are applicable to all tonnage of goods loaded or unloaded from a ship, applicable to all terminals throughout the port territory.
- 2) The fee referred to in paragraph (1) shall be payable within 30 days of the date of invoice of any amount owing, failing which compound interest of 1.5% (18% per annum) is payable monthly.
- 3) The fees prescribed in this notice shall be payable by the corresponding terminal operators as soon as they become payable.
- 4) The fees prescribed by this notice are in addition to any other fees prescribed by another notice or that may be due to the Authority.
- 5) Duties and interest are also payable by His Majesty in right of Canada or a province.
- 6) Fees are payable to the « Montreal Port Authority ».
